The Reserve at Pilottown HOA Board met at the home of Beth Wells on February 1, 2025.

- 1. Larry Firment will be added to the HOA checking accounts replacing Michael Tupman.
- 2. All invoices and checks written on the RaP accounts for ≥ \$1000 will require the full Board approval.
 - a. In the past year, the only payment for that amount was for the new mailbox clusters.
- 3. Karen is taking steps to secure a date for the Annual Meeting this fall. We are looking into the option for absent homeowners to email their voting proxy designations to the Board to ensure a quorum is present.
- 4. Excessive Spam appearing on the Reserve at Pilottown email account was greatly reduced after Karen removed the Board members' personal email addresses from the website. Any non-homeowner wishing to contact the Board can fill out the Contact form on the website.
- 5. Ellen O'Brien has kindly offered to maintain our existing RaP website. Karen will train her on the site in late February.
- 6. Seventeen homeowners have not yet paid their dues which were due in mid-January. Beth will ensure all 17 received the initial dues request letter. When an email is sent to all homeowners, we've discovered that if multiple emails are entered for a homeowner, Gmail chooses only one. This has led to some homeowners not receiving emails. Karen will telephone any homeowners with outstanding dues in mid-February.
- 7. Going forward, important emails to all homeowners (e.g. the annual dues request) will be sent without attachments since some homeowners' email spam filters send attachments to their Spam folder.
- 8. Overall, the mailbox cluster replacement was a success. The contractor and post office finished the work a day early enabling an earlier-than-expected resumption of mail delivery. The Board wants to thank Kathy McDonough and Kevin O'Neill for all the work they did to make this happen without undue stress or delays.
